## **Senior Transportation Planner**

Under the supervision of the Transportation Planning Manager, the Senior Transportation Planner will be responsible for supporting the day-to-day transportation planning functions of a busy Regional Planning Agency (RPA), one of thirteen across the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, with responsibility for twenty-seven municipalities (four cities and twenty-three towns).

## **Responsibilities Include -**

Determining methods to be used in studies, research, and data analyses.

Conducting field evaluations and assessments, including consumer surveys.

Identifying issues to be addressed and opportunities that can be capitalized upon through enhanced planning and implementation of planning best practices.

Drafting reports, assembling successful grant applications, and preparation of detailed study-related documents and correspondence, and presenting at or facilitating meetings on transportation topics such as, but not limited to, corridor planning, safety, transit, and complete streets.

Serving as staff liaison to pedestrian and bicycle and other multi-modal transportation committees throughout the region.

Working collaboratively with a wide range of internal and external stakeholders.

Assisting with updates and maintenance of various plans and programs, including the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).

Partnering as needed on other planning initiatives across the agency.

Attendance at in-person or virtual night meetings required.

## Qualifications -

Bachelor's degree in urban and regional planning, engineering, geography, or related field and a minimum of three years in a professional capacity. A graduate degree may be substituted for the required experience.
