Builds upon previous work and leads to subsequent work (for example, the towns of Marion, Carver, and Lakeville used DLTA to fund a portion of their Master Plans and used local funds to complete the plans);

Promotes regional collaboration and local commitment;

Consistency with PDAs and PPAs;

Promotes the Housing Choice Initiative; and

Regional in scope (collaborative projects in more than one community).

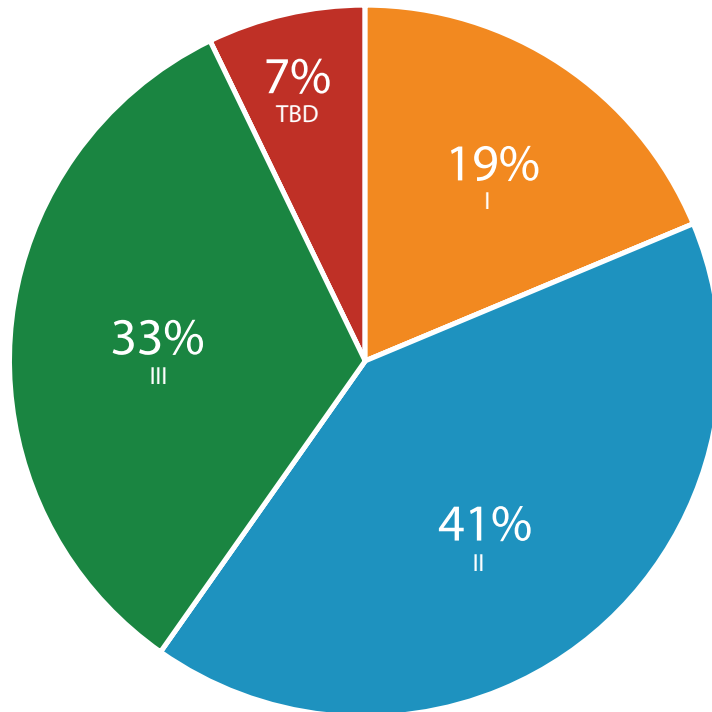

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2019 District Local Technical Assistance (DLTA)

This was the most competitive year in DLTA’s 11-year history. We received 20 applications and 10 inquiries for an estimated value of over \$500,000 - double SRPEDD’s DLTA allotment.

SRPEDD funded 14 discrete projects. Many of these projects build on previous DLTA work, implement adopted Community Compact (CCC) Best Practices, and bring matching resources to the table. This year’s DLTA funds created an estimated 90% match from various local, state, and federal sources.
