About SRPEDD

SRPEDD is the regional planning agency for 27 communities of Southeastern Massachusetts. In cooperation with MassDOT, SRPEDD is responsible for the planning and programming of all modes of transportation including highways, public transit, freight, bicycles, and pedestrians. Our work is regionally based, but community focused. We work to formulate and implement plans that will achieve quality of life improvements, and to ensure that these plans reflect the expressed needs of our 4 Gateway cities and 23 towns. SRPEDD also provides technical assistance to our cities and towns and to the region's two transit authorities, Greater Attleboro Taunton Regional Transit Authority (GATRA) and Southeastern Regional Transit Authority (SRTA). SRPEDD's office, based in Taunton, MA, is currently operating under a flexible, hybrid work policy.

Position Summary/Duties

SRPEDD's Transportation Department is seeking a self-starting team player who enjoys collaborating, as well as working independently, and is resourceful enough to take the initiative on projects.

The Transportation Planner under the supervision of the Transportation Planning Manager participates and assists with data collection, analysis, and public engagement efforts for a variety of projects.

Program specific duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Assisting with deployment and retrieval of Automatic Traffic Recorders on roadways within the SRPEDD region, and all required duties associated with this effort.
- Data collection including but not limited to complete streets, drone flights, bus riding, trails mapping, turning movement counts, environmental infrastructure assessments, etc.
- Transcription of data into databases, spreadsheets, and other analytical software programs.
- Development and presentation of reports and graphics on analysis results.
- Assist with compilation and assembling of crash data to assist in identifying high crash intersections and corridors for study specific safety analyses.
- Participation in safety audits of corridors and intersections.
- Assistance with public engagement and community outreach events.

Qualifications and Educational Requirements

Bachelor's degree in urban and regional planning, geography, or related field and a minimum of one to two years in a professional capacity desired.

A valid driver's license, personal transportation, and a clean driving record are required, with an agency vehicle sometimes available for field work.

While SRPEDD does not have a residency requirement, preference will be given to residents of SRPEDD member municipalities.

Salary and Benefits

\$45,000 to \$50,000 to start, depending upon qualifications.

SRPEDD offers a highly competitive benefits package, inclusive of health insurance through the Massachusetts Group Insurance Commission (GIC), dental, vision, life, and disability insurance, medical and childcare flexible spending accounts, retirement pension through the Massachusetts State Employees Retirement System (MSERS), and a Section 457 Deferred Compensation (MA SMART) plan with employer match. SRPEDD also offers a flexible and hybrid work schedule, competitive time off, sick leave bank, and twelve paid holidays per year.
