

Task 4.1 - GATRA Technical Assistance

Objective: Provide technical planning services that include the development of service alternatives, identification of operational efficiencies, service expansion opportunities, and environmental justice and Title VI equity analysis.

Procedures:

1. Upon request by GATRA Administration, provide technical analysis including but not limited to, existing transit service, potential service alternatives/analysis, environmental justice and Title VI equity analysis, mapping and data, Automated Vehicle Location (AVL) data assistance.
2. Assist with public outreach efforts relative to schedule changes. Participate in neighborhood meetings, organizational meetings and public outreach meetings as requested to inform and engage the public with regards to transit. Follow guidelines to meet the requirements and criteria specified in state and federal regulations as well as the PPP.
3. Assist with improving public participation, EJ and Title VI outreach efforts and in identifying transportation needs of EJ and Title VI populations.
4. Conduct studies as requested, such as the feasibility of establishing locations of bus stops along fixed route systems.
